2. The Director General, National Police Bureau, Islamabad has communicated that 4th August, 2016 was celebrated as a historic day with great honour to commemorate the sacrifices of Police Shuhada and requested for observance of the same this year. It is, therefore, directed that "04th August 2017" will be observed as "National Police Shuhada Day" at CPO, Punjab and Regional/District Hqrs at 10:00 AM with uniformity as per following sequence:


- Guard of Honor at Shuhada's monuments
- Recitation of Holy Quran
- Fateha Khawani for the Shuhada
- Observance of one minute silence in remembrance of the Shuhada
- Tribute to Shuhada by the IGP/RPO/CCPO/CPO/DPO
- Tribute to Shuhada by the Chief Guest
- Families of some Shuhada belonging to the province/city be invited and acknowledged on stage
- Local communities may be invited, including media, elected representatives, notables, Judiciary, Bureaucrats, celebrities, teachers, students, youth etc.
- Lunch

3. Following arrangements will be ensured at CPO, Punjab and Regional/District Hqrs to celebrate this historic event:

- To set backdrops and video screens.
- Reception committee be framed and conducting officer be deputed for receiving of Shuhada families.
- Transport will be provided for pick and drop to the families of Shuhada.
- High level Security arrangement shall be maintained.
- Illumination evening be observed a day before. Candles will be enlightened on three main points.

- Civilian society must be activated through media coverage with Shuhada movies and songs.
- All Shuhada pictures will continuously be displayed on back drop.
- Venues be decorated with the banners and standees.
- All events held will be recorded and videos be kept and shared with media.

4. The Addl: IGP, Operations, CPO, Punjab will liaise with field formations regarding arrangement of above programs whereas DIG Welfare, CPO Punjab is nominated as Focal Person for activities at CPO, Punjab. Necessary arrangements in this regard may please be ensured well in time in true letter & spirit.
