NOTIFICATION

No. 2290 /EXEC-III, In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (1) of Article 7 of the Police Order, 2002 (C.E. O. No. 22 of 2002) as well as approval of the Provincial Cabinet in its 24th meeting held on 27.03.2025 conveyed by the Home Department vide letter No. HP-II/2-3/2025, dated 08.04.2025, the **Crime Control Department (CCD), Punjab** is hereby constituted with the following mandate:

I. OPERATIONS WING:

- (1) Execute all operations against the criminals.
- (2) Infiltrate and operate against Organized Crime.
- (3) Draw/execute-operational strategies against criminals.
- (4) Arrest and hand over suspected criminals to Investigation Wing.
- (5) Implement plans chalked out by the CCD.
- (6) React/operate proactively against criminals through its own manpower.
- (7) Monitoring of criminals.
- (8) Coordination with Police and other Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) for the execution of operations.
- (9) Crime Control Force shall be a non-uniform force. However, they shall wear uniform during trainings and wherever notified by the head of the department.

II. INVESTIGATION WING:

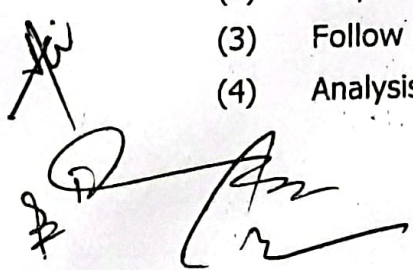
Investigation of cases of the following categories:

- (1) Dacoity/Robbery.
- (2) Dacoity/Robbery with Murder.
- (3) Dacoity/Robbery with Rape.
- (4) Kidnapping for ransom.
- (5) Extortion.
- (6) Target and Contract Killings.
- (7) Vehicle snatching.
- (8) Vehicle theft.
- (9) Burglary where organized gangs (minimum two (02) members) are involved.

- (10) Drug Trafficking.
- (11) Any other case Involving inter-district or inter-provincial gangs.
- (12) Display of Weapon and Firing.
- (13) Serious and organized crime where mobile phones, electronic devices or Internet is employed.
- (14) Cases related to serious and organized crimes.
- (15) Co-ordination with prosecution.
- (16) Preparation and submission of challans.
- (17) Surveillance and maintenance of record of criminals.
- (18) Things to do containing un-arrested criminals and suspects.
- (19) Track and apprehend fugitives for extradition.
- (20) Coordinate with international agencies for extradition procedures.
- (21) Provide security and transport for extradited individuals.
- (22) Review extradition case files.
- (23) Process case files and maintains case records.
- (24) Work with informants to locate high-value targets.
- (25) Monitor suspects before apprehension.
- (26) Design strategies for capturing wanted criminals.
- (27) Compile intelligence on high-reward criminals.
- (28) Manage reward payments and fund allocation.
- (29) Gather data from crime scenes and police stations.
- (30) Confirm criminal backgrounds during investigations.
- (31) Storage and comparison of already fingerprints, DNA and digital evidence.
- (32) Maintain criminal records and ensures security.
- (33) Update case history and respond to record requests.
- (34) Oversee released individuals under supervision.
- (35) Conduct in-person compliance checks.
- (36) Manage GPS tracking devices.
- (37) Review rehabilitation progress reports.
- (38) Maintain violation reports and court updates.

III. LEGAL WING:

- (1) Continuous consultations regarding collection of evidence, etc.
- (2) Preparation of witnesses.
- (3) Follow up of cases till judgment.
- (4) Analysis of acquittals.

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- (5) Request for filing of appeals to the concerned department.
- (6) Legal opinions.
- (7) Dealing with court matters.
- (8) Coordination with the Public Prosecution Department.

IV. INTELLIGENCE WING:

- (1) Intelligence gathering about criminal involved in organized crimes.
- (2) Surveillance of criminals released from jails.
- (3) Use of human and technical means of surveillance.

V. TECHNICAL WING:

- (1) Maintenance of a database of the criminals.
- (2) Maintain a digital repository of gang and interrogation reports.
- (3) Maintain of digital record of gang members, facilitators, financiers and families.
- (4) Technical monitoring facility.
- (5) Access to call data record and location.
- (6) Technical wing to be focal point for availability of technical data.
- (7) Audio/video surveillance.
- (8) Sketch drawing section.
- (9) Maintenance of Technical equipment.
- (10) Geo-fencing.

VI. MONITORING WING:

(a) SEX OFFENDER:

- (i) Monitor high-risk offenders post-release, e-tagging subject to legal cover.
- (ii) Ensure offenders follow court-ordered restrictions.
- (iii) Work with neighborhoods to provide safety briefings.
- (iv) Maintain offender profiles and compliance reports.
- (v) Develop monitoring protocols and legal guidelines.

(b) RELEASED FROM PRISONS:

- (i) Oversee released individuals under supervision.
- (ii) Conduct in-person compliance checks.
- (iii) Manage GPS tracking devices subject to legal cover.
- (iv) Review rehabilitation progress reports.
- (v) Maintain violation reports and court updates.

VII. TRAINING WING:

- (1) Organized crimes investigation courses and trainings.
- (2) Intelligence training.
- (3) Analysis training.

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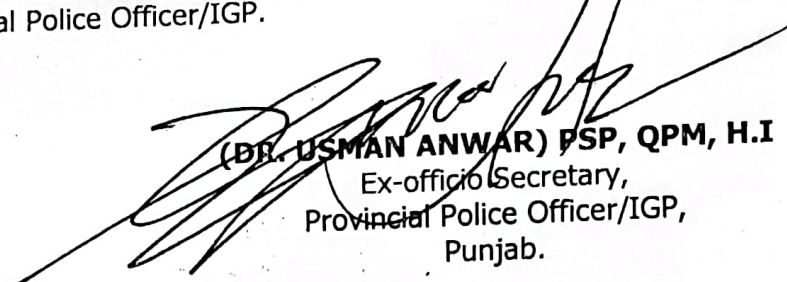
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- (4) Technical training.
 - (5) Police work training.
 - (6) Cybercrime training.
 - (7) IT related training.

VIII. CCD Police Station: (To exercise powers as given in chapter XIV of Cr. P.C and Article 21 of the Police Order, 2002)

- (1) Respond to emergencies and routine patrols.
- (2) Handle crime scene investigations.
- (3) Manage station operations during shifts.
- (4) Record, register and processes citizen complaints.
- (5) Handle administrative tasks and resource allocation.

IX. SUPERVISION AND OVERSIGHT:

- (1) CCD is established under Article 7(1) of the Police Order, 2002.
- (2) The Additional IGP CCD, Punjab shall supervise the working and performance of CCD.
- (3) The Addl. IGP CCD, Punjab may appoint or re-appoint any official/officer on contract basis (extendable) under relevant rules/law.
- (4) The Addl. IGP CCD, Punjab shall work under the supervision of the Provincial Police Officer/IGP.
