MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN LAHORE POLICE AND AWT BLOOD BANK.

Memorandum:

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MOU") is made between:

- **Lahore Police**, acting through the Deputy Inspector General of Police (DIG) Operations, Lahore;
- **AWT Blood Bank**, a blood bank registered with the Punjab Blood Transfusion Authority (PBTB);

Lahore Police and AWT Blood Bank are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Organizations".

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this collaborative partnership is to promote and organize voluntary blood donation, wellness initiatives, and strengthen the availability of safe blood for emergency and routine patient care. Furthermore, it aims to enhance the health and well-being of Lahore Police personnel through health awareness, educational programs, comprehensive health screening, medical consultation, and follow-up diagnostic support where clinically indicated.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF AWT BLOOD BANK

AWT Blood Bank shall:

1. Organize and conduct voluntary blood donation camps at locations identified by Lahore Police.
2. Ensure all blood units are collected, screened, processed, stored, and issued in compliance with the Punjab Blood Transfusion Safety Act, 2016 and applicable standards.
3. Conduct mandatory screening for Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, HIV, Syphilis, and Malaria using FDA-approved testing methods for every donated blood unit.
4. Maintain collected blood in AWT Blood Bank's regulated inventory and reflect availability on the live dashboard, accessible for Lahore Police personnel, their families, and other patients in need, subject to applicable laws, inventory availability, and medical priority.
5. Provide periodic reports on blood donation camps, donor participation, and blood inventory, as mutually agreed.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF LAHORE POLICE

Lahore Police shall:

1. Facilitate voluntary blood donation and medical camps by providing suitable premises, utilities, operational support, coordinating with relevant units, and arranging donor participation.
2. Promote voluntary blood donation among Lahore Police personnel through awareness campaigns and internal communication initiatives.

4. DONOR BENEFITS

AWT Blood Bank agrees to provide the following benefits to eligible Lahore Police personnel who donate blood through this collaboration:

- Complete Health Profile Check-up (35 tests) at no charge.
- Follow-up medical consultation for review of test results.

- Free reflex testing where any lab test in the health profile is found outside the reference range and additional confirmatory testing is clinically indicated.
- AWT Life Saver Card entitling the donor to:
40% savings on diagnostic tests with home sampling services for the donor's friends and family. 10% discount on pharmacy purchases at participating AWT Blood Bank partner pharmacies.

5. JOINT AWARENESS AND HEALTH PROMOTION

- I. The Parties shall jointly organize awareness campaigns, seminars, workshops, and educational activities to promote voluntary blood donation, blood safety, preventive healthcare, healthy lifestyles, and awareness of common diseases.
- II. The Parties may collaborate on health screening camps, wellness initiatives, and public awareness events for the benefit of Lahore Police personnel, their families, and the wider community.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

- I. The Parties shall comply with applicable laws and regulations relating to medical confidentiality and data protection.
- II. No personal health information shall be disclosed to any third party without lawful authority or the written consent of the concerned individual.
- III. Each Party shall ensure that access to donor and patient information is restricted to authorized personnel only.

7. TERM AND TERMINATION

- I. This MOU shall remain in force for three (3) years from the date of signing, unless terminated earlier in accordance with this clause.
- II. Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving thirty (30) days' written notice to the other Party.
- III. The transfer, retirement, or posting of any officer or representative of either Organization shall not affect the validity or continuity of this MOU.

8. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

This MOU does not create any financial obligation on either Organization unless separately agreed in writing.

9. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

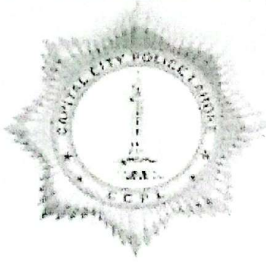
Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this MOU shall, in the first instance, be resolved amicably through consultation between the authorized representatives of the Organizations. If such resolution fails, the matter shall be referred to the competent authorities of the respective Organizations.

10. AMENDMENTS

Any amendment or modification to this MOU shall be made in writing and signed by the authorized representatives of Lahore Police and AWT Blood Bank.

It is submitted that the Operations Wing, Lahore, has signed a **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with AWT Blood Bank** to promote voluntary blood donation, wellness initiatives, and strengthen the availability of safe blood for emergency and routine patient care, as well as to enhance the health and well-being of Punjab Police personnel through health awareness, educational programs, comprehensive health screening, medical consultation, and follow-up diagnostic support. The key details of the partnership are as under: –

- a) **Blood Donation Camps:** AWT Blood Bank shall organize blood donation camps at locations identified by Punjab Police, ensuring compliance with the Punjab Blood Transfusion Safety Act, 2016.
- b) **Screening & Testing:** AWT Blood Bank shall conduct mandatory screening for Hepatitis B, C, HIV, Syphilis, and Malaria using FDA-approved methods.
- c) **Police Support:** Lahore Police shall facilitate camps by providing premises, utilities, and donor participation.
- d) **Donor Benefits:** AWT Blood Bank shall provide Health Profile Check-up (35 tests), follow-up consultation, free reflex testing, and AWT LIFESAVER Card (40% discount on diagnostics & 10% on pharmacy).
- e) **Coordination:** Designated focal persons from both sides shall ensure smooth implementation.

2. In view of the above, it is requested that the enclosed MOU be circulated to all RPOs, CPOs, and DPOs across Punjab for the welfare of police personnel and their families, please.
