So far as, contents of Policing Plan 2024-25, keeping in view the aforementioned provisions of the Police Order 2002, directions of the higher authorities, pattern of crime and social behavior in the District.

The undersigned assumed the charge as District Police Officer, Bahawalpur on 05.02.2023.

Efforts have been made efficiently by using the available resources by the Department in maintaining law and order, prevention and detection of crime and in curbing sectarianism, terrorism and extremism. The District Police of Bahawalpur is committed to play a positive role in the administration of Criminal Justice system.

Different projects e.g. Khidmat Marakiz, Khidmat Counters at THQ Level, Anti Women Harassment & Violence Cell, Investigation Support Unit, HRMIS, Complaint Management System and DLIMS have been started by utilizing Information Technology. The complaints received through Hon'ble Supreme Court (HRC), Prime Minister's Office (PMDU), Chief Minister's Office, Chief Secretary's Office, Ombudsman's Office and IGP's office (1787) etc. are being dealt on priority basis and monitored closely. Welfare centre for police officials is working at district police office Bahawalpur. New Building of PS Civil lines PS Dhorkot PS sadar yazman PS Musafir khana and PS anayti are under construction. 1. INTRODUCTION:

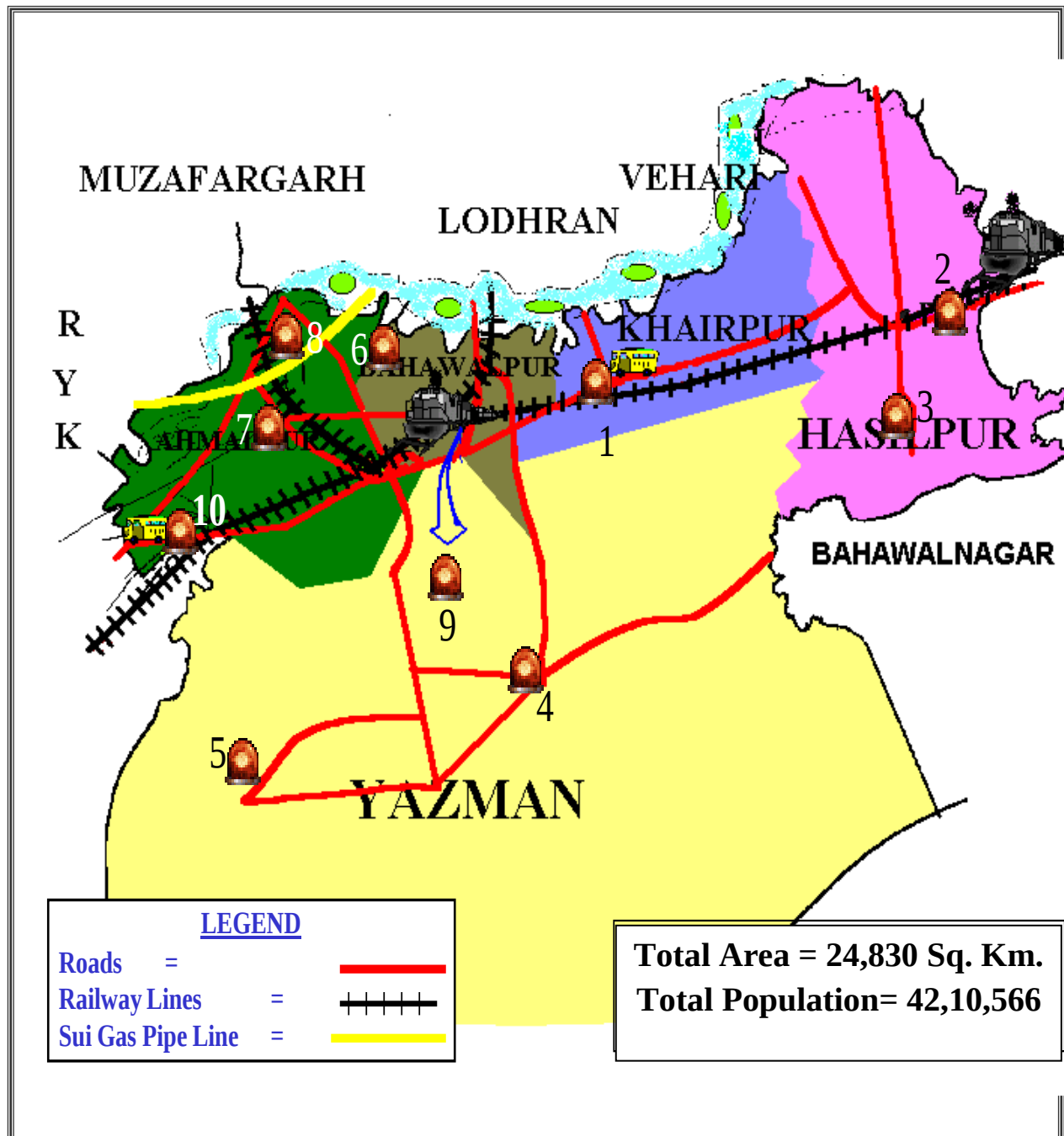
I. Brief Introduction of the plan;

With the changing scenario of the world, quality policing has emerged as an essential ingredient to maintain law & order situation and to create a crime free environment. With changing modus-operandi and use of sophisticated methods by the criminals, there was a need to equip the police with modern gadgets and means so that the criminals could be dealt with iron hands. Although resources have increased to meet the said requirements, annual policing plan 2024-2025 is devised according to Article 32(4) of Police Order 2002. The immediate purpose of the plan is better means of communication and more vehicles, quality policing by minimizing the response time and quick action, better control over crime and in time delivery of service.

II. District Detail;

The present district of Bahawalpur was previously known as “Bahmanabad”. In 1729 Nawab Amir Sir Sadiq Muhammad Khan Abbasi conquered it. His son “Nawab Amir Bahawal Khan” when came into power, he established capital of his State at Bahmanabad and named it after his own name as “Bahawalpur”. Accordingly, the whole State owned by him was also named as Bahawalpur State. Being populated by Muslims in majority, the ruler of the State opted for Pakistan in the year 1947. The present Bahawalpur District was created on 14th October 1955.

The territory of Bahawalpur district lies between the latitude of 27-48 to 29-50 North and between the longitudes of 70– 54 to 70–50 East. The district forms one of the southern parts of the Province of Punjab and is situated almost in the center of the country at the eastern border at an elevation of 152 meters from the sea level. The general slope of the district towards the sea is gentle, with an average gradient of 0.19 meter a kilometer. The average length from north to south is about 178 kilometers and breadth from east to west is 139 Kilometers.

PHYSICAL FEATURES AND TOPOGRAPHY.

1) PHYSICAL FEATURES.

The district Bahawalpur, from all the sides, is land locked. In the South and South East, the Cholistan reaches the Indian border whereas in the north it runs parallel to the southern part of the Punjab plains and river Satluj makes common border with the Lodhran, Muzaffargarh and Vehari Districts.

2) TOPOGRAPHY

The district Bahawalpur topologically can be divided into three parts i.e. the riverine area, the plain area and the desert area. The riverine area lies close to the river Satluj which flows from the north along its boundary with Vehari, Lodhran, Multan and Muzaffargarh districts. The area is inundated during floods. The irrigated track is higher than the riverine area. Most of the land has been brought under cultivation. The desert area is known as “Cholistan”. It lies to the south and east of the irrigated track and north of the desert of Bikanir and Jaisalmer of India. It extends along the entire eastern boundary of Bahawalnagar district in the North and Rahimyar Khan district in the south. The surface of the desert consists of a succession of sand dunes rising in some places. The barren tract of Cholistan/Rohi is inhabited by nomadic shepherds.

It is actually a part of Indian desert known as “ THAR”. Cholistan means waterless-waste land. Cholistan has been declared as GAME RESERVE (JEEP RALLY).

The former Bahawalpur State, which consisted of only two districts of Bahawalpur and Rahimyar Khan, was later on categorized into three districts with the addition of Bahawalnagar District.

Before 1866, there was no Police Department in the Old Bahawalpur State. The regular Police Department came into being in 1867. Then, for the first time, Police Stations were established in Bahawalpur. The District Headquarters lies on the main Lahore - Karachi Railway line of Pakistan Railways. The Karachi, Lahore, Peshawar Road (KLP Road) also passes through it. It is also linked with the Provincial Capital Karachi, Lahore and Islamabad through P.I.A.

NATURE OF CRIMES, COMMITTED IN THE DISTRICT

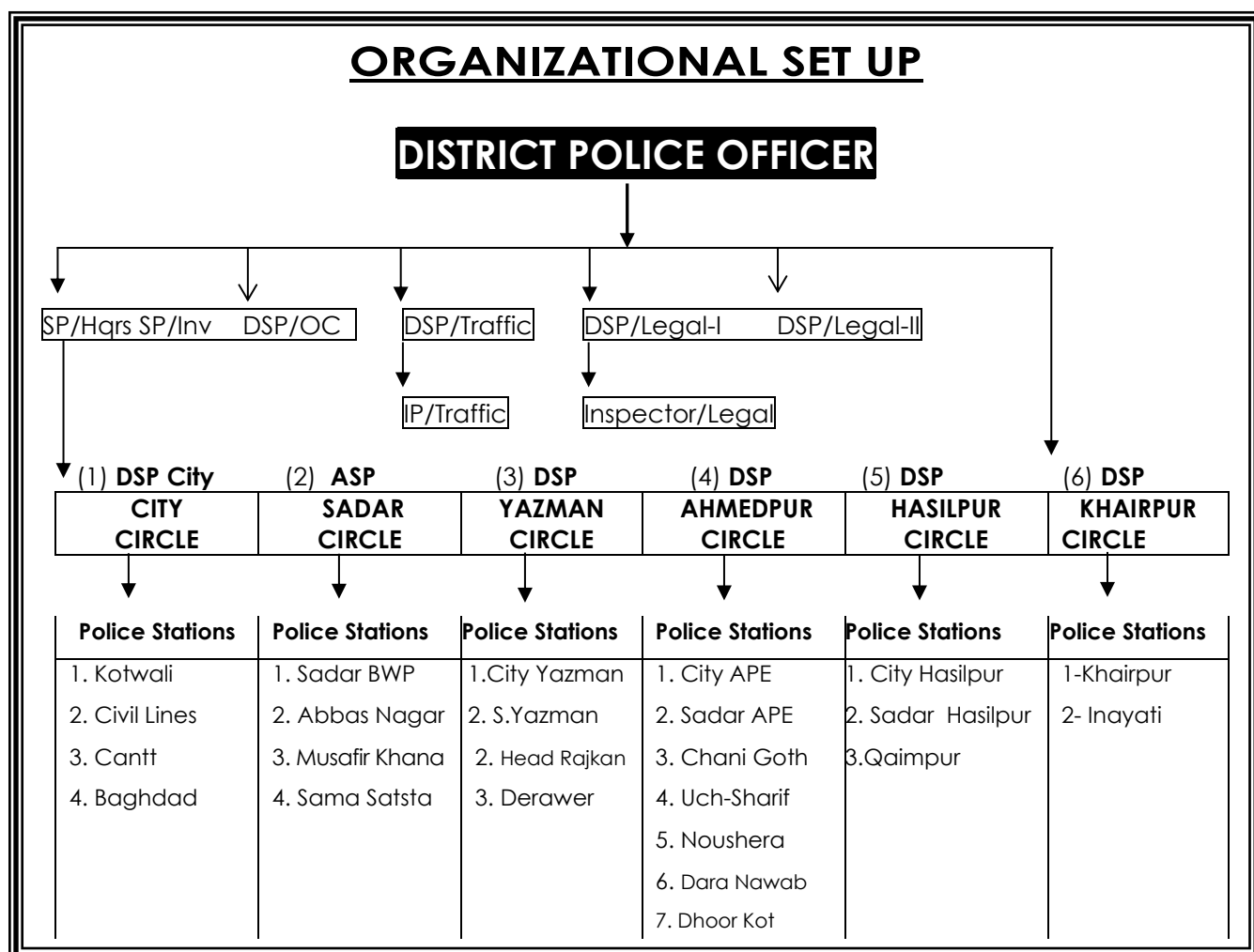
Like most of the Districts, the Riverine areas are infested with cattle-piracy. As one goes towards cities, the crime of vehicle theft, motorcycle snatching and burglary is more predominant.

Although the system of “Rassagiri” does not exist in the District, yet some “Zamindars” sitting in Riverine-belt provide shelter to the cattle-lifters. However, due to persistent campaigns launched against the cattle lifters, the incidents of cattle lifting has decreased. Being a large district, it has crime of every nature e.g murder, abduction, rape, dacoity, robbery and theft etc. Like other major cities of Punjab, Bahawalpur is also facing the phenomena of street crime.

Extension in important towns has started a process of urbanization which still continues. People from more densely populated areas of interior Punjab are still attracted to this district because they consider that there are charming prospects of earning livelihood by bringing barren land under cultivation.

5. WELFARE PROJECTS

a) **Financial Aid to Police Force and Widows Deceased & invalid Persons**

During the current financial year, special attention was paid to the welfare of the police force and the maintenance for widows Rs.9078909- in deceased retired and invalid persons.

b) **Welfare of widows of martyrs of Police force.**

This important aspect of the welfare of the force is never ignored and on the eve of Eid-Day Ramzan 23 March Pakej and Yum-e-Takrem Shuhda days in the year 2023-24, an amount Rs1054000- was distributed to widows/legal heirs of 29 Martyrs of this district.

c) Educational Scholarships for the children of employees.

During the current financial, an amount of Rs.10183856/-was paid to school and college going children of Police Shudah of the police employees which has boosted up the morale of the force and encouraged the students.

d) Wheelchairs, and deaf instruments to special children of police force have been provided amounting to Rs.340000/-

d) Police Welfare Markaz

During the current financial established an online welfare desk for police officer and officials. Easily accessible from every police station, online application.

6. I.T INITIATIVES

i. Special initiatives Police Stations

Baghdad ul Jadid Police Station of District Bahawalpur has converted into special initiative Police Station as per SOP and is fully functional since mid of January 2020

ii. Merging of PUCAR 15 and District wireless control

PUCAR 15 and District Wireless Control are merged under one roof to improve communication and response time against crime calls.

i. Establishment of DTIT

A special branch named District technical investigation team is established in DPO office for technical assistance in form of CDR analysis Geo fencing location finding.

ii. Police Khidmat Marakiz.

Police Khidmat Marakiz have been established at following different places to provide 14 basic services at door step of citizens under one roof. i.e. driving license, character verification, lost report, temporary residence report, FIR copy etc.

v. **Video link installation.**

Video link system has been installed at all offices of DSPs/ SDPO to conduct video link meetings with circle officers and complainants as well.

vi. **PUCAR 15 establishment. (پکار 15)**

15 helpline systems have been upgraded to PUCAR 15, which has synchronized these calls with CPO office. The system has improved response mechanism to address emergency 15 complaints.

vii. **IT Room.**

An IT room has been established in DPO office to for monitoring of IT Initiatives, i.e. PSRMS, CMS, Hotel eye, AVLS, TRS and Front Desk Cameras for good performance and removing negligence for better public service delivery.

viii. **Trackers Monitoring System Tasks.**

Trackers have been installed in Police Stations (Mobile 1), Elite Vehicles and Muhafiz Squad and dolphin force bike to monitor the movement and to guide them about tracks in backward areas. This will help to monitor their fuel consumption as well.

ix. **Upgradation of police lines.**

Following steps have been taken to upgrade police lines Bahawalpur.

- Establishment of modern recreation hall
- Upgradation of police lines mess hall, and cafeteria

- Improved infrastructure of main gate of police lines for better security purposes and beautification.
 - Up gradation of Break to model Barak or employees
- x. **Pure Water Plant**
An RO plant in Police lines which provide clean water to police officers to avoid diseases and for their better health so they can perform duty more efficiently.
- xi. **Police Welfare Branch**
District Police Welfare branch is providing welfare services to in Service, all retired, died during revise and Shuhada's Families, at their door steps on priority basis.
MOUs with private Schools/Colleges have been signed for concession in fee for children of police officers/officials.
- xii. **Syed Ahmed Mubeen (Shaheed) Police Driving Training School Bahawalpur.**
A driving training school has been established in this district where driving training to citizens is provided under the supervision of District Traffic Officer.

7. INVESTIGATION

- Superintendent of Police investigation has been appointed as head of investigation wing. Transparency and fair play are the main objectives in conducting investigations of the cases.
- The investigation officers adopt different techniques which are cases specific. Such method rarely produce any evidentiary leads. The techniques like thorough interviews and interrogations, surveillance and various tests are important tools of investigation.
- Hard effort are being materialized for submission of challan within stipulated period of time.
- Early trial of criminal cases ensured through vigorous prosecution.
- Complete/Incomplete challan and interim reports u/s 173 Cr.PC will be submitted in courts within stipulated period of time.
- Investigation teams will be constituted in Kidnapping for ransom cases.

- Refresher courses are being conducted for investigating officer with the help of judiciary and prosecution department.
- Investigation Support Unit also established under the supervision of SP/Inv. to boost up the investigation and to assist from the registration of FIR to conviction.
- AWH&VC also established under the supervision of under signed. SP/Inv. is focal person of the cell. This cell deals with women issues and redress their grievances in time. At P.S level, lady victim support officers also deputed for this purpose.
