Subject: MOU BETWEEN LAHORE POLICE & BALI MEMORIAL TRUST.
Memorandum:

It is submitted that the Operations Wing, Lahore, has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Bali Memorial Trust, Lahore, to collaborate for the protection, rehabilitation, and welfare of vulnerable groups in society, including women, men, children, the poor, and persons with disabilities. The key details of the partnership are as under:-

- a) **Coordination Focal Person:** Punjab Police shall nominate one focal person for coordination in the smooth implementation of this MOU.
- b) **Referral of Women in Crisis:** Punjab Police shall refer selected cases of Women in Crisis, including forced marriages, runaway girls/women denied fundamental rights, victims of domestic violence, and victims of sex trafficking, to the shelter home of Bali Memorial Trust for provision of free legal aid and rehabilitation, considering the circumstances of the victim party.
- c) **Referral of Poor and Disabled Persons:** Punjab Police shall also identify and refer poor and disabled individuals requiring welfare support to Bali Memorial Trust.
- d) **Support in Workshops & Sessions:** Punjab Police shall provide all possible support to the Trust in convening workshops and sessions on Women Protection, Welfare of Poor and Disabled Persons, and Rehabilitation, by identifying and inviting police officers to attend such sessions, preferably at police premises such as Police Lines, Police Training Schools, and Committee Rooms.
- e) **Technical Assistance by Trust:** Bali Memorial Trust shall provide necessary technical assistance in the development of a referral strategy to bring all relevant stakeholders onboard for the protection and rehabilitation of Women in Crisis, as well as poor and disabled persons.
- f) **Shelter & Rehabilitation Services:** Bali Memorial Trust shall provide shelter to women in selected cases of Domestic Violence and Forced Marriages identified and referred by Punjab Police in the District of Lahore, along with extending welfare and rehabilitation services to poor and disabled individuals in need.
- g) **Gender Sensitization & Capacity Building:** Bali Memorial Trust shall arrange sessions and workshops for selected police officers with the aim to enhance their gender sensitization and capacities to handle Women and Girls in Crisis, while also improving their knowledge of issues faced by poor and disabled persons, relevant laws and policies, and existing resources to effectively and timely respond to their needs.
- h) **Awareness Material:** Bali Memorial Trust shall undertake the development, printing, and dissemination of awareness material to be displayed at Police Stations for wide public awareness on the availability of shelter homes for the protection and rehabilitation of Women in Crisis, as well as welfare services for poor and disabled individuals.

2. In view of the above it is requested that enclosed MOU be circulated to all RPOs, CPOs and DPOs across Punjab for the welfare of police personnel and the vulnerable communities they serve, please.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN LAHORE POLICE AND BALI MEMORIAL TRUST

Memorandum:

Lahore Police and Bali Memorial Trust agree to collaborate for the **protection and rehabilitation of vulnerable groups in society**, including women, men, children, the poor, and persons with disabilities. This partnership is designed to provide legal aid, shelter, and welfare services to those affected by forced marriages, domestic violence, intimate partner abuse, exploitation, and other forms of crisis.

2. The Parties shall jointly organize sessions and workshops on protection and welfare, rehabilitation mechanisms, relevant legal frameworks, and referral systems. These initiatives will strengthen coordination among stakeholders and ensure that the rights and dignity of all vulnerable groups are safeguarded.

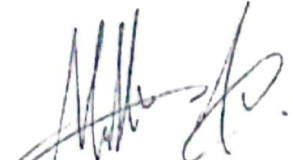
3. The Lahore Police and Bali Memorial Trust have accordingly agreed to the following roles and responsibilities: -

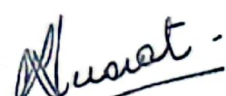
Sr.	FOR PUNJAB POLICE	FOR BALI MEMORIAL TRUST
I	Will nominate one focal person for coordination in smooth implementation of this MoU.	Will provide necessary technical assistance in the development of a referral strategy to bring all relevant stakeholders onboard for the protection and rehabilitation of Women in Crisis, as well as poor and disabled persons requiring welfare support.
II	Will refer selected cases of Women in Crisis related to forced marriages, runaway girls/women denied their fundamental rights, victims of domestic violence, and victims of sex trafficking, for provision of free legal aid and rehabilitation considering the circumstances of the victim party, to the shelter home of Bali Memorial Trust. In addition, Punjab Police shall also identify and refer poor and disabled individuals requiring welfare support.	Will provide shelter to women in selected cases of Domestic Violence and Forced Marriages, identified and referred by Punjab Police in the District of Lahore, along with extending welfare and rehabilitation services to poor and disabled individuals in need.
III	Will provide all possible support to the Trust in convening workshops and sessions on Women Protection, Welfare of Poor and Disabled Persons, and Rehabilitation, by identifying and inviting police officers to attend workshops and sessions, preferably at police premises such as Police Lines, Police Training Schools, and Committee Rooms.	Will arrange sessions and workshops for selected police officers with the aim to enhance their gender sensitization and capacities to handle Women and Girls in Crisis, while also improving their knowledge and understanding of issues faced by poor and disabled persons, relevant laws and policies, and existing resources to effectively and timely respond to their needs.

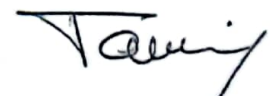
- IV** Will facilitate awareness campaigns by allowing placement of informational material at police stations, ensuring visibility of welfare initiatives for women, poor, and disabled persons.
- Will undertake the development, printing, and dissemination of awareness material to be displayed at Police Stations for wide public awareness on the availability of shelter homes for the protection and rehabilitation of Women in Crisis, as well as welfare services for poor and disabled individuals.

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed jointly by Lahore Police and Bali Memorial Trust as a commitment to uphold justice, extend welfare to poor and disabled persons, and ensure that vulnerable women and children in crisis receive timely legal aid, shelter, and rehabilitation without discrimination or financial barriers.


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
