Subject: MOU BETWEEN LAHORE POLICE & LAHORE BAR ASSOCIATION.

Memorandum:

It is submitted that the Operations Wing, Lahore, has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the **Lahore Bar Association**, to constitute a Legal Aid Panel for providing free legal assistance to poor and needy complainants appearing in open court proceedings of Lahore Police. The key details of the partnership are as under :-

- a) **Objective:** To provide free legal aid to underprivileged complainants who cannot afford legal representation, ensuring their legitimate concerns are properly addressed.
- b) **Panel of Lawyers:** The Lahore Bar Association shall nominate a panel of volunteer lawyers willing to provide free legal services.
- c) **Referral of Cases:** Lahore Police shall identify cases requiring legal assistance and refer them to the Legal Aid Panel.
- d) **Legal Services:** Nominated lawyers will provide legal advice, representation, and necessary court support to referred complainants.
- e) **Coordination:** Designated focal persons from both sides shall maintain coordination to ensure smooth implementation.
- f) **Police Support:** Lahore Police will facilitate access to complainants and provide necessary documentation and cooperation.
- g) **Bar Association Role:** The Bar Association shall ensure availability of lawyers, maintain a roster, and oversee performance of the panel.

2. In view of the above, it is requested that the enclosed MOU be circulated to all RPOs, CPOs, and DPOs across Punjab for the welfare of needy citizens and facilitation of police proceedings, please.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN LAHORE POLICE AND LAHORE BAR ASSOCIATION**

Memorandum:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made between **Lahore Police** and the **Lahore Bar Association** with the purpose of constituting a Legal Aid Panel to provide free legal assistance to poor and needy complainants who appeared in open court proceedings of Lahore Police.

2. Lahore Police regularly receive complaints from citizens seeking redressal of grievances related to police operations. While officials under the administrative control of Lahore Police take immediate action on operational matters, it has been observed that many of the cases brought before the Bar are of a legal nature and require representation or legal advice/assistance in court. A significant number of these complainants belong to underprivileged segments of society and are unable to afford legal services. Their inability to access proper legal representation often hinders the resolution of their legitimate concerns.

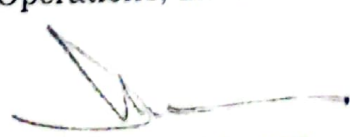
3. In order to uphold justice and humanitarian values, both institutions agree to collaborate in providing free legal aid. The Lahore Bar Association, in consultation with the Lahore Police shall nominate a panel of lawyers willing to volunteer their services for poor and needy complainants. Lahore Police shall identify cases requiring legal assistance and refer them to the Legal Aid Panel, while the nominated lawyers will provide advice, representation, and necessary legal support. Coordination between Lahore Police and Lahore Bar Association will be maintained through designated focal persons to ensure smooth functioning of this initiative.

4. Under this arrangement, Lahore Police will facilitate access to complainants, provide necessary documentation, and ensure cooperation, while the Lahore Bar Association will ensure the availability of lawyers, maintain a roster, and monitor the performance of the panel.

5. This MoU is signed on behalf of both institutions as a commitment to serve the cause of justice and ensure that no citizen is denied legal support due to financial constraints.

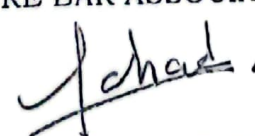
