MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on ____ of January 2025, by and between:

Punjab Police, located at Lahore city, hereinafter referred to as "Punjab Police"

The Punjab Police, an Integral Law Enforcement Agency in the province of Punjab, Pakistan is responsible for maintaining public order and safety. The Punjab police force is led by the inspector General Police and is dedicated to upholding the rule of law, preventing and investigating crimes, and ensuring the security of the citizens of Punjab.

And

Minhaj University Lahore (MUL), located at Madar-e-Millat Rd, near Civic Center Township Commercial Area Lahore, Punjab-5477; hereinafter referred to as "MUL"

MUL is a premier general university looking to collaborate with industry and corporate sector to facilitate its students and alumni in terms of providing opportunities of training, career counseling and consultancy facilities

1. Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to establish a collaborative relationship between MUL and Punjab Police to enhance the academic and professional skills of students.

2. Scope of Collaboration

The collaboration will focus on areas such as internships, research projects, and professional training aimed at improving the employability and practical experience of students.

3. Roles and Responsibilities

a) Punjab Police

- I. Conduct seminars and workshops for intellectual grooming and academic success of students.
- II. Provide Internship & Training Opportunities for MUL students.

b) MUL

- I. Offer its premises for workshops and seminars to Punjab Police as and when required with mutual consent.
- II. 20% discount to children of police department employees who were martyred, injured, or passed away during duty.
- III. 20% discount to children of current or retired employees or the employees pursuing further education.

4. Financial Arrangements

Both parties understand that any financial considerations associated with any form of collaborations will be dealt with separately.

5. Duration

This MOU shall remain in effect for an initial period of 3 years from the date of signing. The agreement may be renewed for additional periods, subject to mutual consent and written agreement between the parties.

6. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any proprietary or sensitive information exchanged during the course of this collaboration. Neither party shall disclose any information without prior written consent from the other party.

7. Termination

This MOU may be terminated by either party with 30 days written notice to the other party. In the event of termination, both parties agree to fulfill any outstanding obligations under this MOU.

8. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising from this MOU shall be resolved through mutual consultation and negotiation. If a resolution cannot be reached, the dispute shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the applicable laws of Pakistan.

9. Amendment

Any amendments or modifications to this MOU must be made in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both parties.

10. Miscellaneous

- a) This MOU does not create any legal obligations or liabilities for either party beyond those explicitly stated herein.
- b) Both parties agree to work in good faith to achieve the objectives outlined in this MOU.

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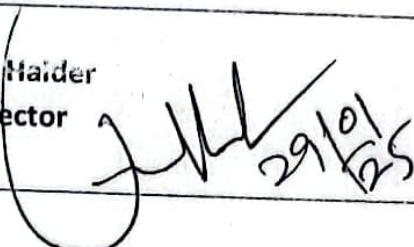
