

Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Punjab Police

&

Noor Thalassemia Foundation



This document is an agreement describing the responsibilities and expectations between **Punjab Police** and the **Noor Thalassemia Foundation**. The objective of this Memorandum is to serve the community, including the families of Police employees by saving precious lives of Thalassemia and Hemophilia patients through raising awareness and blood donation camps at Punjab Police.

Terms and Conditions are hereby established between Punjab Police and Noor Thalassemia Foundation:


1. Noor Thalassemia Foundation will provide free of cost treatment including laboratory tests to the children of Police employees suffering from Thalassemia, Hemophilia, and other blood major disorder.
2. Children of Police employees suffering from Thalassemia and blood disorders visiting Noor Thalassemia Foundation will be entertained, registered, and given facility of blood transfusion.
3. A periodic exchange of list of registered children of Police employees will also be shared by the Foundation.
4. Noor Thalassemia Foundation will also help/ provide blood voluntarily to police department in case of emergency.
5. Punjab Police will facilitate Noor Thalassemia Foundation to arrange blood donation camps in Police premises as needed.
6. Noor Thalassemia Foundation will follow all the guidelines/ protocols of screening as per WHO standards to collect blood such as HB percentage, Weight, Fever, HCV and HbsAg, etc.

7. Noor Thalassemia Foundation will be responsible to arrange thermal gun, face mask, sanitizer, HB kit, blood shaker, disposable gloves for donors, disposable head cover, latex gloves for staff and volunteers, and refreshments for donors with juices, biscuits, water, etc., extension boards, weighing machine, bleeding bags, and other necessary medical equipment.
8. Blood donations made by the police employees will not be sold. It will only be donated.
9. Noor Thalassemia Foundation is bound to give Punjab police the complete data of blood donations by police whenever required.
10. Noor Thalassemia Foundation will provide Punjab Police with hard and soft copies of donors and results of blood tests.
11. Punjab Police will make all the possible efforts to engage a maximum number of blood donors but will not be responsible if numbers decrease or increase due to any reason.
12. This agreement is for an initial period of one year, from the date of signing i.e. ----- --. It May be extended/ renewed with the mutual consent of the parties.
